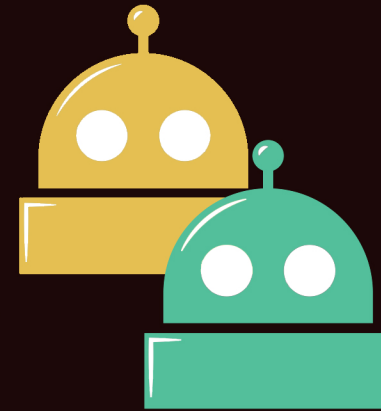
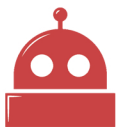


What is ATS?

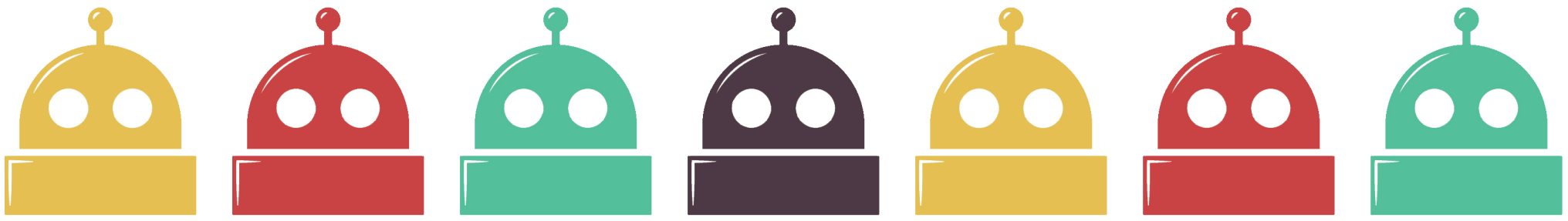
